



## Modern Slavery Policy

**EDGE DESIGN WASHOOMS** recognises that it is responsible to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and operates the following policies in its approach to the identification of modern slavery risks and the prevention of slavery and human trafficking in its operations.

The organisation encourages all its workers, customers and other business partners to report any concerns related to the direct activities, or the supply chains of, the organisation. This includes any circumstances that may give rise to an enhanced risk of slavery or human trafficking.

The organisation's code makes clear to employees the actions and behaviour expected of them when representing the organisation.

The organisation is committed to ensuring that its suppliers adhere to the highest standards of ethics and the organisation uses only specified, reputable employment agencies to source labour.

The organisation undertakes due diligence when considering taking on new suppliers, and regularly reviews its existing suppliers.

The company evaluates the modern slavery and human trafficking risks of each new supplier reviewing on a regular basis all aspects of the supply chain and creating annual risk profiles for each supplier.

The company will not support or deal with any business knowingly involved in slavery or human trafficking.
